



Sophomore Dual Credit Early Admissions Approval

South Plains College will allow sophomores in high school to enroll concurrently in dual credit classes if they meet the **exception rule** mentioned in the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board policy/rule below:

“To be eligible for enrollment in a dual credit course offered by a public college, students must have a least junior year high school standing. **Exceptions** to this requirement for students with **demonstrated outstanding academic performance and capability (as evidenced by grade-point average, PSAT scores, or other assessment indicators)** may be approved by the principal of the high school and the chief academic officer of the college. Students with less than junior year high school standing **must demonstrate eligibility** as outlined under subsection (b) (1) of this section”.

Therefore, the undersigned representatives of the high school and South Plains College approve the named sophomore student to enroll in dual credit classes based on:
