### **SPC students to visit NASA's Johnson Space Center**

LEVELLAND – Twelve South Plains College students will participate in the Community College Aerospace Scholars program on April 14-16 at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA) Johnson Space Center in Houston. This is the fourth year that SPC has participated in the program.

The Community College Aerospace Scholars program is part of the Texas Aerospace Scholars and was created by the state of Texas, in partnership with JSC and the Texas educational community, to encourage community and junior college students to enter careers in science and engineering. During the two-day event, students will participate in a team project directed by NASA engineers, attend briefings, tour facilities and interact with students from across Texas.
