SPC Technology Program to offer career options for area high school students

LEVELLAND – Six area schools will bring approximately 200 high school students to South Plains College to participate in the 2009 Freshmen Peek set for 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday (April 21) on the Levelland campus. The students will tour and explore career opportunities in the SPC Technical Education Program.

The students will gather in the Texan Dome before dispersing into groups to tour the campus. Students will be attending from Lubbock Cooper, Crosbyton, Levelland, Lockney, Morton and Smyer.

The SPC Technical Education Program offers training and certification in Business Administration and Computer Information Systems, Creative Arts, Industrial Technology and Professional Service and Energy. Students will participate in hands-on demonstrations in the various training areas.
