THE PROGRAM

South Plains College offers students a technical program in accounting that prepares the student for work as a junior accountant. The program is offered at the college's Levelland Campus and at the Lubbock Center. Students who satisfactorily complete this two-year curriculum will receive an associate of applied science degree. An optional plan for a certificate of proficiency is also offered.

Students seeking a four-year transfer accounting degree should follow the business administration degree plan. South Plains College's accounting associate program offers you the opportunity to study areas necessary to compete in today's fast-paced business world. The classroom settings at SPC encourage the open exchange of ideas necessary to develop reasoning skills. Additionally, up-to-date computer hardware and software provide you with an opportunity to use microcomputers for business applications and study.

DEGREES & CERTIFICATES

Students completing the two-year accounting associate program receive an associate of applied science degree. This degree will provide you with the specialized skills and the credentials to attain gainful employment in an accounting-related position. The program consists of 60 semester credit hours of accounting and business-related course work.
